Community groups and/or organizations requesting a FREE-SPACE reservation at the Crossroads Farmers Market must be a not-for-profit organization offering information regarding market related and/or community services. To apply for a free-space, please follow the instructions outlined below:

1. To request a free-space, complete this form and mail it to Crossroads at least one month before date(s) requested. Your organization will receive a letter/email confirmation of reservation a few weeks before the requested date of participation.
2. Free-space reservations are in demand and requests may be limited to one Tuesday per market season on a first-come-first-serve basis. Market Management will determine further availability as space permits.
3. You will be assigned to a tent and provided with a table space and chairs, unless arrangements are made.
4. Information may be distributed from the tent area only. No microphones, electronically enhanced presentations are permitted, without Market approval.
5. Free-space groups are subject to all Market Rules unless otherwise specified.
